We are going to do another school on the 28th of April, it's not too late to find more people who want to share in the fun of our great club. We hope everyone has a great 2019 of Rallying.

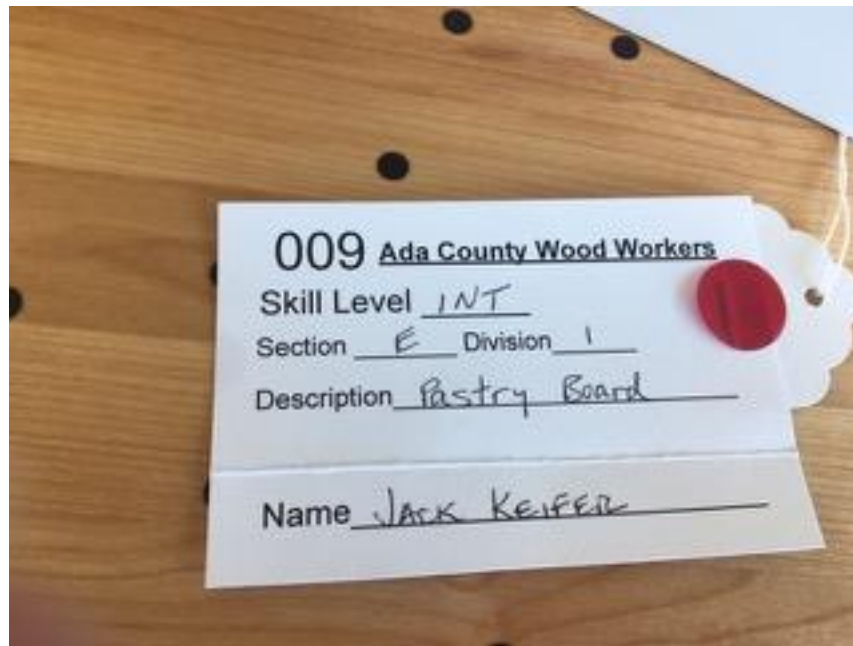
